The gospel of John has been described as a book children can wade in and elephants can drown in. One way to stay afloat is simply following the basic patterns of Jesus teaching. One author notes, "We can think of John's gospel, especially Jesus' discourses, as spirals. Important thoughts for our faith keep coming back to us, working stronger faith in us, as we follow the spirals upward." We'll examine how the gospel of John enlightens our mind and guides us in understanding. The following list details the topics for each week.
